O what wonder! How amazing! Jesus, glorious King of kings, deigns to call me his beloved, lets me rest beneath his wings.

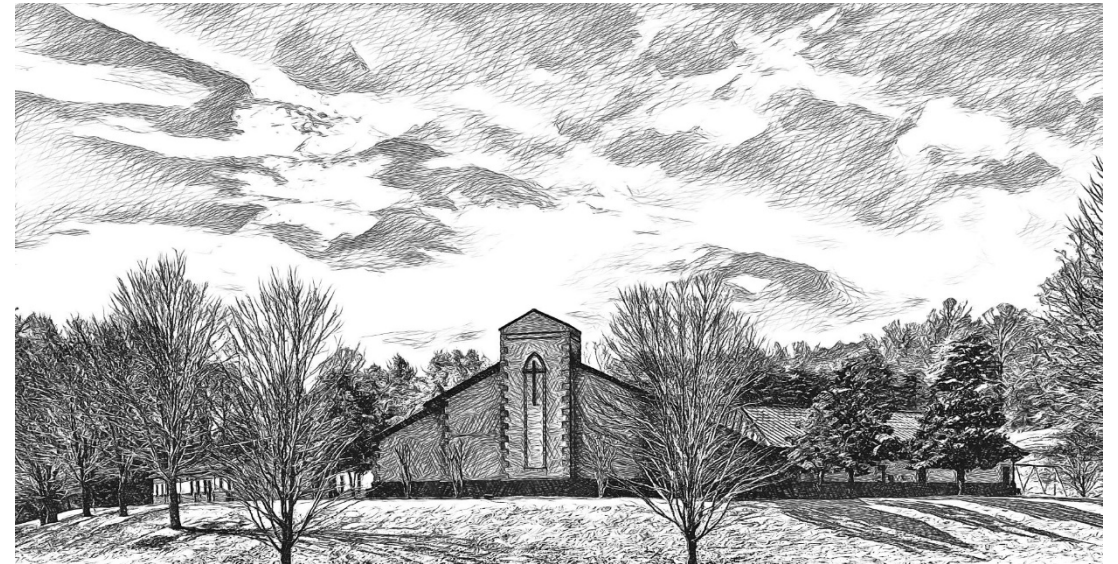
TAKE MY LIFE, AND LET IT BE
