Scripture Lesson 1 Peter 2:4-10

Sermon Series on 1 Peter #8 Rev. Dr. H. Andrew Silman

Season of Silent Reflection, Confession and Prayer

Christ is laid across the path of humanity on its course into the future. In the encounter with him each person is changed: one for salvation, another for destruction.... One cannot simply step over Jesus to go on about the daily routine and pass him by to build a future. Whoever encounters him is inescapably changed through the encounter. Either one sees and becomes “a living stone,” or one stumbles as a blind person over Christ and comes to ruin, falling short, i.e., of one’s Creator and Redeemer and thereby of one’s destiny. (L. Goppelt, quoted by K.H. Jobes, in 1 Peter, p. 155)

God’s love is evidently prior to ours: “He first loved us.” (1 John 4:19) God’s love is the cause of ours. “We love him because he first loved us.” Therefore, going back before all time, when we find God loving us with an everlasting love, we gather that the reason of His choice is not because we loved Him, but because He willed to love us. His reasons are known to Himself, but they are not to be found in any inherent goodness in us or which was foreseen to be in us. We were chosen simply because He will have mercy on whom He will have mercy. He loved us because He would love us. The gift of His dear Son was too great a sacrifice on God’s part to have been drawn from Him by any goodness in the creature.... Our redemption, like our election, springs from the spontaneous self-originating love of God. And our regeneration, in which we are made actual partakers of the divine blessings in Jesus Christ, was not of us nor by us. We owe our new birth entirely to His potent love, which dealt with us by effectually turning us from death to life, from darkness to light, and from alienation of our mind and the enmity of our spirit into that delightful path of love.
