Silent reflection and prayer

Nothing moves the heart, and therefore the will, like recollections of the grace of God in hours of need, like the guidance of the Lord in difficulties, the power of God in victories, and the patience of God in periods of weakness and temptation. These in themselves are sufficient to produce a response to the claims of God upon us. (Gleanings in Joshua, A.W. Pink, p. 425)

In his final address to the Israelites, Joshua ... reminds the people that it is only by God's sovereign choice that they have been the recipients of his blessing. He warns them about taking his covenant blessings for granted.... In the generations that were to follow, Israel went through many cycles of sin and repentance. Eventually, after reaching the Promised Land, the Hebrews did suffer the covenant punishment God predicted would happen if they strayed from Him. (What's In the Bible, R.C. Sproul & Robert Wolgemuth, pp. 67-68)

What are your gods? What gods did you leave when you made the great first choice to become a Christian? God says, "You chose once for all to be a Christian. Fine. Continue to choose, continue to choose, continue to choose – moment by moment, existentially. You must continue to choose between the old gods and me, the living God."
