Silent Reflection and Prayer

It may be asked how does one get joy? It comes only with Him who Himself is the God of all joy. The extent to which He occupies the ground of my whole being, that is the extent to which I have His joy. If Christ controls and has His way in my career, business, hobbies, home, friendships, service, and interests, whatever they may be, there I will also experience His joy. It is quite literally impossible to be at variance with God in any area of life and there find joy. Joy is part and parcel of harmony with Him in my activities. The instant I comply with His wishes, His joy energizes my being. The moment I disagree with His desires joy fades, and faith falters. As Christ comes into our affairs His desire is that our attention and interest be refocused on Him. It is He who is at work within us both to will and do of His own good pleasure (Philippians 2:13). Too often we are looking for joy when we should just be looking away to Jesus Christ. Our joy is in Him. Our strength is in His ability to produce the joy. W.
